Students must be prepared to answer questions following their presentation. Students provide evaluation questionnaire to a minimum of two people (provided by instructor) to complete during the presentation. Students also complete the evaluation questionnaire following their presentation. Both sets of evaluation questionnaires are turned in to the instructor by the due date. Students choose one of the following topics for the research paper:

- In Defense of The Existence Of God
- In Defense of The Biblical Creation Account
- In Defense of The Virgin Birth
- In Defense of The Resurrection
- In Defense of The Trinity
- In Defense of A Literal/Personal Devil
- In Defense of The Consistency Of Salvation In The Old \& New Testaments
