REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning November 27 with extended hours on Wednesday and Thursday, January 3 and 4, 10:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. **Students registering after January 4 will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late fee. This includes registrations for all Module A courses.**

RETURNING STUDENTS

Returning students from the last two semesters are encouraged to register through Oasis, (Student Information System), even for those on the payment plan. **Any and all registration activity (using any method) must include complete information on the registration form and will only be finalized with appropriate payment for fees and tuition.**

NEW STUDENTS

New Students must submit a completed application with personal testimony and application fee prior to registration. **College and Seminary applications should be submitted by Thursday, January 4, 2024 for proper processing.** Requests for the online application and information may be submitted to the Administrative Offices through the Carver's website: www.carverbiblecollegekc.org, by phone (816-333-1577, Ext. 7101), or in person. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process. After admittance, **new students should contact the Registrar's Office to register for classes.**

PAYMENT PLAN

If you qualify for our tuition payment plan, **all fees and 25% of tuition** are due by January 4. The remaining balance is due in monthly payments on the 1st of each month through April. **All balances must be paid before receiving a "Cleared for Finals" approval.**
